Arkansas School For Advanced Studies Northwest Arkansas Dyslexia Screening and Intervention Report

Summary of Program

During the 2024-2025 school year, Arkansas Schools for Advanced Studies used the evidenced-based Sonday Systems Level 1 & 2 Dyslexia Intervention Program in small group intervention to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia. The Sonday System 1 and 2 offers structured, systematic, multisensory reading intervention for readers at the beginning stages of reading through eighth grade. Each lesson plan uses proven Orton-Gillingham methods to provide effective intervention in small-group settings.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention

During the 2024-2025 school year, 7 students attending Arkansas Schools for Advanced Studies received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting Characteristics of Dyslexia

During the 2024-2025 school year, 11 students attending Arkansas Schools for Advanced Studies were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.
